Pathfinders Fundraiser Talent Show

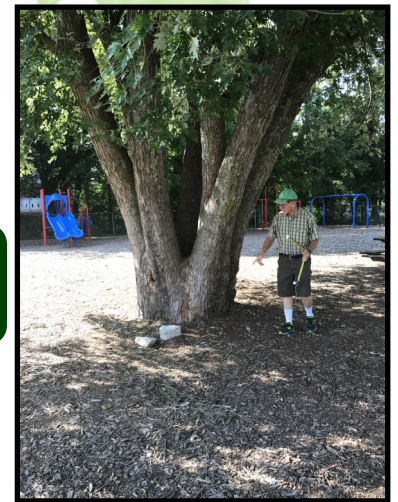

Wanting to play a BAND instrument—trumpet, trombone, clarinet, flute? A retired band teacher has moved to Dalton and has offered to teach private instrument lessons (\$25). If interested, contact Carmen Swigert 706-529-4533.

Needing VOICE or PIANO lessons? Check with Mrs. Knowlton. She may have a few more openings! (\$25/lesson).

Interested in VIOLIN? Mrs. Chung is willing to teach 5th-7th students who have never played the violin but are interested in learning. She can take up to 6 students and will start mid-January. There is no charge for the lessons. Violin rentals cost is \$20 a month, shoulder pad is \$25 (one time fee), and deposit is \$100. Commitment needed from each student is practicing 30 minutes at least 4-5 times a week. A time sheet must be turned in each week. If students cannot keep this commitment, they will be dropped from the program. Because this is a volunteer teaching commitment for only the school season, parents need to be committed to make sure their child practices. We only want students who will cooperate and make this music journey successful and enjoyable. Students who are already taking violin lessons may be able to join with the beginner class once these new students have learned a hymn and are ready to perform.
